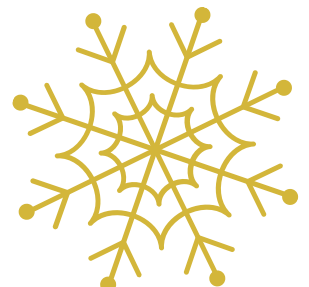

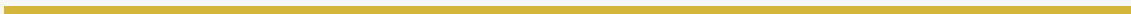


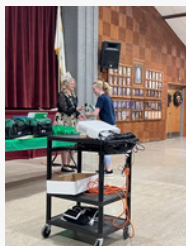
On November 20, 4-H youth and adult volunteers were honored at the 2023 annual 4-H Achievement Night.

2023 Community Wellness Recap



- **Tipton Community School Corporation Share Tables**: This year TCSC and Extension received funding to implement a food rescue/food access initiative within the high school. The USDA guidelines for school lunches mandates that each student take specific food groups at each meal. TCSC staff had noticed how much of this food was being thrown in the trash and was determined to make a change. The Share Table allows students to donate unwanted food items, which meet certain food safety criteria, to a designated area to allow other students, who may not have access to healthy foods at home, the opportunity to take an extra food item. At the end of the day, any leftovers are available for after-school activities.



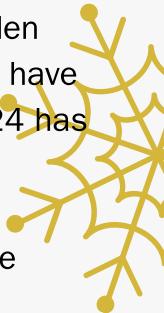
- **Tipton Community School Corporation Staff Wellness**: As a fairly new idea, TCSC and Extension are partnering to create a central workout area for staff. In 2024, we plan to continue designing this area, apply for funding, and start the implementation process. The intention is to increase physical activity among TCSC staff, which we expect to promote overall health, mental health and wellbeing.



- **Howard County Donation Garden**: In 2023, the Howard County Food Access Alliance was named as a new nonprofit entity, and the group has been working to identify resources to improve food access throughout the county. As a member of this working group, I have been working closely with the Alliance's director to create plans for a community garden that is expected to support over 10 food pantries in Howard County. Although we still have much planning to do before moving forward, we are extremely optimistic for what 2024 has in store for this initiative.



- **Growing Together Grants**: Both Howard and Tipton counties received funding from the Growing Together Grant. This grant is intended to increase access to fresh fruits and vegetables for limited-resources families in Indiana through collaboration with active Master Gardeners, the Purdue Extension Nutrition Education Program, Purdue Extension educators, and community volunteers. Howard produced over 3,400 pounds of produce and Tipton over 1,000 pounds. We are planning to apply for this grant again in 2024.

On November 2, 2024 our Area 8 staff meeting was held at The Ark in Converse, Indiana.



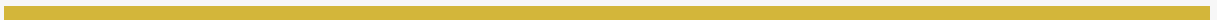
Our meeting included, office discussion regarding impacts with our local stakeholders, team building and goals for 2024.

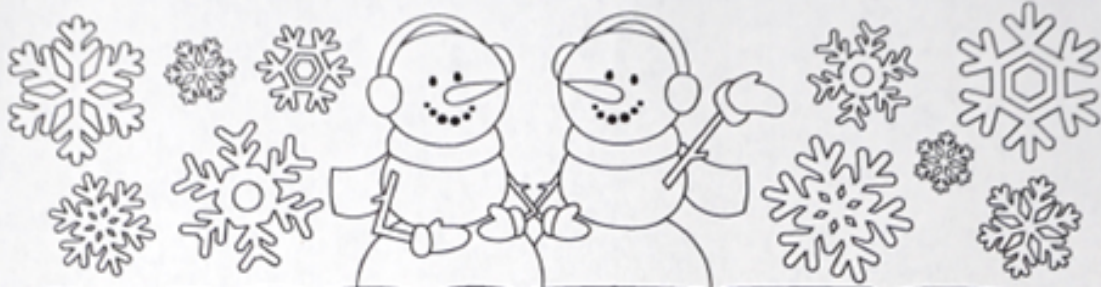
