

State Contests

The Indiana 4-H Consumer Decision Making Contest is an educational opportunity for 4-H members to make decisions as an individual and as a team member. Youth will learn to make decisions based on consumer purchasing information they have learned and studied during this process. During the process of evaluation, youth will also learn to defend their decisions through giving oral reasons. Success depends upon how well they process and evaluate what they have observed. Open to youth in grades 9-12.

Kitchen Skillathon is an educational opportunity for 4-H members to demonstrate increased knowledge and competence with common kitchen equipment, small appliances, herbs/spices, and hazards/safety in the kitchen. Teams will be made up of 3-4 youth in grades 6-8. The contest will consist of four identification stations including small appliances, kitchen equipment/tools, herbs/spices, and kitchen hazards/safety; a written test and a skills demonstration. For the Skills Demonstration, participants can practice, and receive feedback from a judge, on an assigned kitchen/cooking type skill. Participants will complete the skill while at the judging table. The 2023 contest is exhibition only so no points or awards will be given and there is no cost to participate.




