RECORD SHEET MUST BE IN SCRAPBOOK

SCRAPBOOK CHECK LIST

- My scrapbook has a hard front and back cover.

- My scrapbook project has 10 pages completed for judging. The front counts as one page and the back counts as one page. Five pages front and back equals 10 pages.

- Every page in my scrapbook is numbered.

- There are photos or memorabilia on every page to be judged.

- My scrapbook tells a story or follows a theme.

- My scrapbook is neatly done.

- My pages are in chronological order or follow a theme.

- There is journaling on every page that will be judged:
 - Grades 3, 4, & 5: must have who, what, where, and when on each page.

 - Grades 6, 7, & 8: must have who, what, where, and when in sentence form on each page.

 - Grades 9, 10, 11, & 12: must include basic information (who, what, where, and when) and additional details to tell a complete story or memory on each page.
