Sheep and Goat Show Rules

- 1. All participants must present a valid premise ID at check-in. Sheep and goats must have at least flock or scrapie tag or 840 RFID tag.
- 2 Animals must be free of ringworm, sore mouth, and other communicable diseases. Out of state animals must be accompanied by CVI within 30 days of show.
- 3. No artificial filling, injections, or artificial hair of any kind.
- 4. Four head or more animals needed for a breed division. Otherwise will show in AOB.
- 5. Breeding ewes must be born on or after Jan. 1 2022.
- 6. All market sheep and goats will be shown by weight.
- 7. All committee decisions are final.
- 8. No generators allowed in barns.
- 9. No bedding allowed in parking lots or roadways. Bedding must be contained to barns and/or trailers.
- 10. Sheep and goats MUST be in their specific barns and/or trailers near the barns. Due to biosecurity issues, animals may not go in other species' barns. **No animals or show tack permitted in the hog barn.**
- 11. All trailers should be located near the livestock barn.
- 12. All participants must clean up their stall/pen areas before leaving the grounds.
- 13. Cash premiums and ribbons will be awarded at the time of show.
- 14. Breed Champions and Reserve Breed Champions will receive an award.
- 15. Breeding ewe lambs and yearling ewes show for Champion and Reserve Champion by Breed. Breed, AOB, and Crossbred Champions will then compete for overall Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Breeding Ewe.
- 16. Rams will show for Champion and Reserve Champion by Breed. Breed, AOB, and
 Crossbred champions will then compete for overall Grand Champion and Reserve Grand
 Champion Ram.
- 17. Goats will be sub-divided into 2 divisions Meat and Pygmy. All divisions will be considered for Grand Champion Goat. There will be only one Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Meat Goat.
- 18. Ewes can be double entered in breeding and market classes. Each entry is separate so you will pay entry fee twice.
- 19. Breeding does will show by age.
- 20. Parents **can not** show animals only assist if needed.
