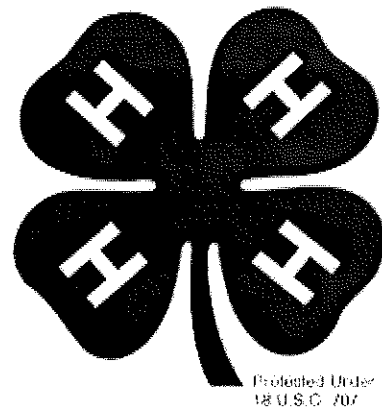

- You may do an action demonstration at any level that involves your collection.

It is therefore recommended that very valuable or irreplaceable collections be protected in a display case, fastened to a display board, or left at home.

You may also contact the Extension Office to create a display that would be more appropriate for your project. No living plants or animals may be displayed as a collection.
