








4-H SCHOLARSHIPS

4-H scholarships are due January 25th! Scholarships are available to those currently in grades 10-12 and one year post HS graduation. Available scholarships include: 4-H Accomplishment Scholarships (many categories, open to grades 10-12 & one year post high school), 4-H Club Scholarship (open to high school seniors planning to attend Purdue University in the fall, majoring in the College of Agriculture or select majors in the College of Health and Human Sciences),

4-H Senior Year Scholarship (open to high school seniors), and Laurenz Greene Memorial Excellence in 4-H Horticulture Scholarship (open to high school seniors attending Purdue University in the fall, pursuing select majors in the Department of Horticulture and Landscape Architecture). Scholarships are to be submitted through 4HOnline under the "Events" tab in your profile for current 4-H members. Must be an approved 4-H member to submit.
