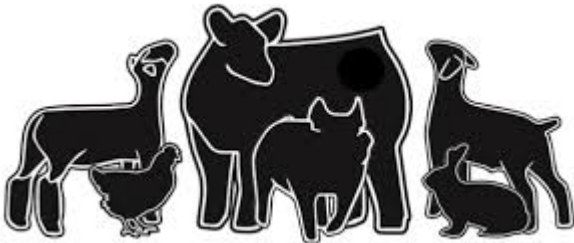
INDIANA 4-H QUALITY LIVESTOCK CARE PROGRAM

Indiana 4-H Quality Livestock Care trainings will be held in person on the dates listed below. If you cannot make it to one of these dates AND/OR will be showing at a national show where YQCA is required, you may take the YQCA course ONLINE only. **If you choose to do this online, you must show me a copy of your YQCA certificate or send me your YQCA certificate by June 1, 2026 so I can mark you as completed for this year.**

To register for the Indiana 4-H Quality Livestock Care program, please go to 2026QLC.4honline.com or log in to your 4-H Online account, go to the Events tab & look for the event titled "Benton, Fountain, Tippecanoe, Warren - IN 4-H Quality Livestock Care." (Please do not add anything under the Trainings tab, we will delete it.) It will ask you which date you will be attending. **The cost of this class is \$3 and must be paid via cash or check at the door on the day of your chosen training.** You will not receive your certificate until this fee is paid. The online YQCA class is \$12. In order to show at county and state fair, you must have a certificate from either YQCA or the Indiana 4-H Quality Livestock Care program. You will not be able to exhibit your animal(s) at the county and/or state fair without one of these certifications.

This year, we will be offering 8 training dates in collaboration with Benton, Fountain & Tippecanoe counties. **Indiana 4-H Quality Livestock Care training dates and locations are below. All trainings will run from 6-7pm.**

2. Monday, April 20th at Benton Co Annex.
3. Monday, May 4th at Fountain Co Fairgrounds.
4. Tuesday, May 19th at Warren Co Ext Office.
5. Thursday, May 21st at Tippecanoe Co Ext Office.
6. Thursday, May 28th at Benton Co Annex.
7. Monday, June 1st at Warren Co Ext Office.
8. Thursday, June 4th at Fountain Co Fairgrounds.

Get to Know Your Leaders & Superintendents!

You are welcome to participate in a township club and/or a project club. If you are a member of a project club, you are not required to be in a township club. However, if you are participating in a project that has a club, we will add you to that club as a secondary if you do not select it yourself. This is to ensure you receive all of the information that may be sent out for your project. Please do not select a project club if you do not wish to participate in that project. 4-H Manuals are distributed through each of the clubs.

4-H Superintendents work to assist and coordinate the activities for the projects. These great volunteers are available to answer your questions related to your 4-H projects.
