

WHAT IS 4-H?

4-H is a hands-on approach to learning new and exciting things all while making new friends. Youth learn important life skills through completing and exhibiting 4-H projects and by attending club meetings, camps, workshops and so much more!

4-H is the youth program of Purdue University's Cooperative Extension Service. Our mission is the education of Indiana citizens through application of the Land Grant University research and knowledge base for the benefit of agriculture, youth, families, and communities. Over 500 young people from Warrick County were club members last year and you can be one too!

HOW DO I JOIN 4-H?

To join 4-H in Warrick County, you must be in 3rd through 12th grades and first choose a 4-H Club. Contact a club leader listed in this brochure or call the Purdue Extension Office for help. Then go to v2.4honline.com to sign-up and pay program fees; here you will enter your club of choice. The cost is \$30 per member up to three members from the same household; then the 4th member and so on is free. 4-H new year enrollment begins October 1st and is always open, however, we encourage you to enroll by January 15th because 4-H programming occurs year-round. Signing up as soon as possible ensures you receive information and resources to make the most of your 4-H experience.

MINI 4-H

Mini 4-H is for K through 2nd grades. You will need to enroll at v2.4honline.com. The cost is \$5. Minis meet January through July. Upon enrollment confirmation, more information providing you the club leader, meeting times and etc. will be sent to your mailing address
