

Mini Horse FairEntry Class # 600856

- Enroll in the Mini Horse Lead Class in FairEntry by July 1st.
- 2. Signed Mini 4-H Liability Release Form due in office by July 1st.
- 3. Participants must wear close-toed shoes.
- 4. Exhibit a Mini Animal Horse Poster covering one of the following topics:
 - A) Favorite Breed
 - B) How to care for a horse.
 - C) Identify the part of a horse.
 - D) Showing a horse.
 - (See handbook for topic descriptions)
- 5. Doing a Mini 4-H Horse Poster qualifies you, if you choose, to show a 4-H member's horse in a Mini 4-H Showmanship class during the Western Show. You may show in either English or Western Attire. Approved headgear must be worn.
- Min 4-H Member will use a separate lead rope. The horse will also be led by an adult using another lead rope.
- 7. Two workshops for Mini members and their mentors will be held between June 15th and the 4-H Fair. These are not required but are encouraged. A Mini 4-H Liability Release Form must be completed and on file with the office by June 15th if participating in these workshops.



Mini Poultry FairEntry Class # 600854

- 1. Enroll in the Mini Poultry Lead Class in FairEntry by July 1st.
- 2. Submit completed Mini 4-H Liability Release Form by July 1st.
- Participants must wear close-toed shoes.
- 4. Wearing long sleeves is recommended when handling poultry.



Mini Sheep FairEntry Class # 600850

- 1. Enroll in the Mini Sheep Lead Class in FairEntry by July 1st.
- 2. Submit completed Mini 4-H Liability Release Form by July 1st.
- 3. Participants must wear close-toed shoes.



Mini Swine FairEntry Class # 600857

- 1. Enroll in the Mini Swine Lead Class in FairEntry by July 1st.
- 2. Submit completed Mini 4-H Liability Release Form by July 1st.
- 3. Participants must wear close-toed shoes.

White County 4-H Mini Animal Lead (Showmanship) Classes



To participate in Mini 4-H Animal Lead Classes at the Fair:

- 4HONLINE: Enroll in White County 4-H by
 May 15th Deadline. (https://v2.4honline.com)
- <u>FAIRENTRY:</u> Enter each individual Animal Lead Class in FairEntry by July 1st Deadline. (https://www.fairentry.com/)
- Mini 4-H Liability Release Form: Parent or Guardian MUST sign a Mini 4-H Liability Release Form and submit to the Extension Office by July 1st Deadline. *Note- A form must be signed prior to member participating in any Animal Lead Workshops that are scheduled prior to the Fair.



Mini Beef FairEntry Class # 600853

- 1. Enroll in the Mini Beef Lead Class in FairEntry by July 1st.
- 2. Signed Mini 4-H Liability Release Form due in office by July 1st.
- Animal weight restrictions—Please see General Rules #3 & #4 regarding member working with animals under 300 lbs. and over 300 lbs.
- 4. Mini 4-H member must work with a beef animal PRIOR to fair. Proof of practice with the animal & Mini Beef Worksheet due by July 10th. Forms available at the Extension Office. Contact a Beef Committee member if you need assistance in finding a family to work with.
- Show Day—Participants must wear long pants with close-toed shoes (leather shoes or heavy boots). Open-toed/sandals are NOT allowed.
- Participants will use animals provided by 4-H members, they will not bring their own .
- 7. Beef Mini Lead will follow Beef Showmanship on Sunday morning at the fair.



Mini Rabbit FairEntry Class # 600855

- Enroll in the Mini Rabbit Lead Class in FairEntry by July 1st.
- 2. Signed Mini 4-H Liability Release Form due in the office by July 1st.
- 3. Participants must wear close-toed shoes.
- Rabbit Mini Lead class will be held at 2
 PM, Sunday of the fair at the Rabbit Barn.
- 5. A rabbit will be provided for all Mini 4-H member participating.

General Rules

- 1) Members will exhibit fellow 4-H member's animal. They WILL NOT bring their own animal to the fair. Members and their families will be responsible for finding a 4-H member who will allow them to borrow an animal for Mini Lead. If assistance is needed with this, please reach out to a member of the livestock barn committee prior to date of show.
- 2) Parent/Guardian of the mini member MUST complete a Mini 4-H Liability Release Form and submit by July 1st. Mini members will be allowed to show, work with, or care for animals projects AFTER their parent/guardian has signed a liability release form.
- Mini members may independently show, work with, or care for animals that weigh 300 pounds or less.
- 4) Mini members may only show, work with, or care for animals over 300 pounds when they are assisted by a parent, legal guardian, or another adult designated in writing by parent or legal guardian. (Adult has control of the animal at all times.)
- 5) If the guidelines stated in this policy are not followed for a particular event or activity, then such event or activity shall not be considered to be a 4-H event or activity and shall not be under the auspices of Extension 4-H educators or covered by Purdue University.
- All Mini Lead classes will be listed in the 4-H Fair Schedule, released in June.

Mini Goat FairEntry Class # 600851

- Enroll in the Mini Goat Lead Class in FairEntry by July 1st.
- 2. Signed Mini 4-H Liability Release Form due in the office by July 1st.
- 3. Participants must wear close-toed shoes. No sandals or open-toed.
- All Mini participants will be assisted by a current goat project member. Goats will be provided.
- Goat Lead Class will be held between Pygmy and Meat Goat Shows on Wednesday of the fair.



Mini Female Dairy FairEntry Class # 600852

- 1. Enroll in the Mini Female Dairy Lead Class in FairEntry by July 1st.
- 2. Signed Mini 4-H Liability Release Form due in office by July 1st.
- Participants must wear close-toed shoes, preferably leather shoes or heavy boots. Opentoed or sandals are NOT allowed.
- 4. Participants will use 4-H member's animals. Participants will not bring their own.
- Inexperienced Mini participants will have other 4-H Dairy members and/or arena workers available to assist them with the animal as needed.
- 6. Mini Lead will follow Female Dairy Showmanship.
