RE: 2023 4-H Camp

Plans are now underway for the 2023 4-H Camp! 4-H Camp is great time and I hope you will consider attending this year! This year's camp will be Wednesday, June 7<sup>th</sup> through Friday, June 9<sup>th</sup>, at Camp Tecumseh, near Brookston. 4-H Camp is open to any currently enrolled White County 4-H member in grades 3-6. We will be joining 4-H members from Cass, Carroll, Clinton, Howard, Miami, Newton, Pulaski, and Tippecanoe counties. This is a great opportunity to meet lots of new friends and experience new things!

The theme this year will be "Having a Ball at Camp" (Sports)! At 4-H Camp you can participate in many activities, including Archery, Canoeing, Crafts, Nature, Foods, Science, Swimming, and Sports. Everyone is expected to attend all of the 4-H Camp classes. Youth will be assigned to a cabin with 10 or 12 other campers and two 4-H Junior Leader counselors. We will do our best to accommodate requests for cabins, but it is not always a possibility.

The cost of the three-day and two-night camp is **\$91.00** per camper, after a partial sponsorship from the White County Ag. Association. This cost includes meals, lodging, insurance coverage, and access to many of the facilities available at Camp Tecumseh. T-shirt cost is included with the total price for camp. Be sure to indicate shirt size on the registration form.

Campers should plan to arrive at camp on Wednesday, June 7<sup>th</sup> between 12:30 and 1:00 p.m. Parents should plan to arrive promptly at 2:45 p.m. on Friday, June 9<sup>th</sup> to pick up campers.

If you would like to go to 4-H Camp, please fill out the enclosed registration form and health form. **Return** the forms, along with your \$91.00 fee to the White County Extension Service Office in Reynolds <u>no</u> <u>later than 4:00 p.m. on April 28<sup>th</sup></u>. Make checks payable to: Purdue CES Education Fund - White County. If you have not yet paid your 4-H enrollment fee, this will be due at the same time in order to reserve your space for camp.

Since we have a limited amount of space available, **reservations will be taken on a first-paid basis**. Only the first 30 White County reservations can be accepted. Any youth after the first 30 will be added to a waiting list. No reservations will be taken after the deadline unless we have a cancellation to fill. After your registration form, health form, and fee is turned in, you will receive a letter with a list of what to bring to camp and other details of 4-H Camp. We hope you can attend! Sincerely,
