All returning 4-H volunteers will need to re-enroll annually using the 4HOnline system. **Beginning October 1st,** volunteers should log into 4HOnline using the login email and password that was used when enrolled in 4HOnline last year @ v2.4honline.com.

- This can all be done with a phone camera, landscape mode please.
- We are looking to create a playlist of 2-3 minute long videos.
- We would love to have some videos ready to go by October 1st but this will be an rolling submission through the winter
