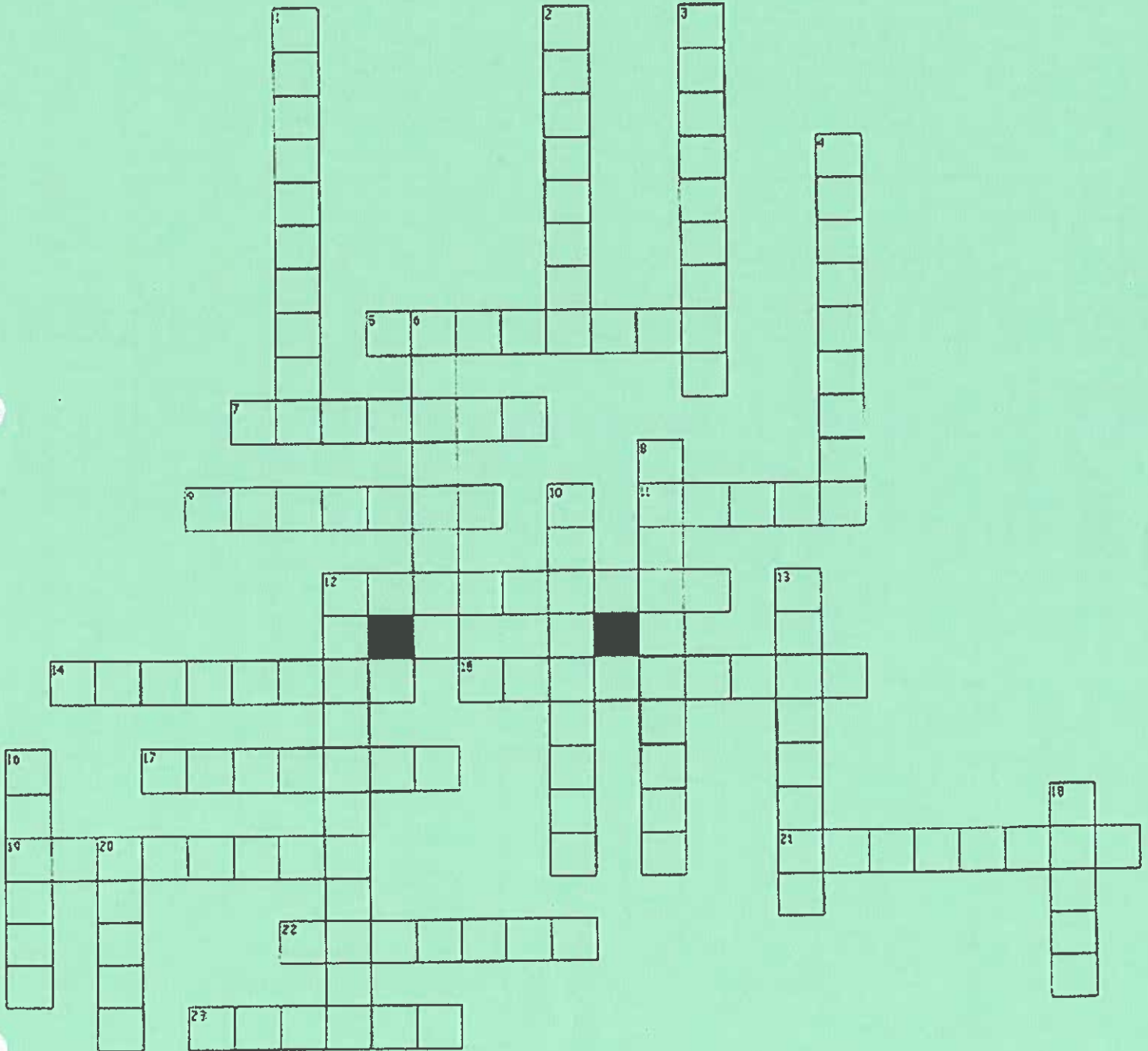

7. Must be $\frac{3}{8}$ Brahman and $\frac{5}{8}$ Angus, solid black and polled.
9. These cattle are polled and blood red in color.
11. These animals are polled with a black, smooth coat.
12. Have pigmented skin under a chestnut red coat and white markings on the back, tail and barrel.
14. They are solid cream to reddish-yellow in color and are known as a general purpose breed with good milking abilities.
15. These animals can be red, white, or roan in color.
17. The color of these animals varies from light gray or red to almost black.
19. They are solid-to golden red in color with lighter circles around the eyes and muzzle.
21. Possess the same qualities for which Black Angus are known and the only difference is that they are red in color.
22. _____ Blue The color can be white, blue roan or sometimes black.
23. They are typically horned and dark mahogany red in color.

1. Have slightly less than $\frac{1}{2}$ Brahman blood and slightly more than $\frac{1}{4}$ of Hereford and Shorthorn breed
2. Texas _____ These animals have long horns and several different color patterns.
3. These animals have red to dark red, spotted bodies with white to lite straw faces.
4. Santa _____ These animals are $\frac{5}{8}$ shorthorn and $\frac{3}{8}$ Brahman.
6. Scotch _____ They may be red, black, yellow, dun or silver-white in color.
8. These animals are solid wheat colored, ranging from cherry to dark blonde, and they have black hair around the eyes and pigmented udders and teats.
10. These animals are large and white and are noted for their fast growth and lean meat.
12. They are white or pale gray with black points.
13. These animals have red bodies with white faces.
16. _____ Hereford Except for the polled trait, these animals exhibit the same characteristics as the Hereford
18. _____ Grey The preferred color is silver-gray, although there are numerous variations in the shading of gray.
20. _____ Anjou The coloring is a very dark red with white markings on the head, belly, and rear leg and tail.
