- Registration submitted by July 3rd-\$2.00 per exhibit, \$10.00 maximum total
 - After July 3rd-\$3.00, maximum \$15.00 total
- You may enter more than one entry per class.
- Cash or Check payable to : *Whitley County Extension Homemakers*
- All exhibits must have been made by the participant within the last two years.
- You may bring your own props for display. Please label them with your name.
- ***Exhibits will be entered at the West Room of the 4-H Center on Wednesday, July 9 between 6:30 p.m. and 8:30 p.m. and Thursday, July 10 between 8:00 a.m. and 10:00 a.m. Judging will begin at 10:15 a.m. on July 10.***
- Each item will be judged by closed judging and awarded a ribbon. The judge may award a winner in each division. A People's Choice award will be announced on Wednesday, July 16.
- ***Exhibits can be picked up on Wednesday, July 16 from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. Anything not picked up, will be available at the Purdue Extension Whitley County office beginning Monday, July 21.***
- The committee reserves the right to form subclasses as needed and the right to act upon any problem not covered by the rules.
- The committee and Extension Homemakers will be very careful in handling exhibits, but assumes no responsibility for lost or damaged items.

Requirement-Must include a recipe card.

5. Quick Bread-Enter one loaf.
6. Muffins-Enter 7 muffins on a plate.
7. Yeast Breads-
 - A. Loaf & Rolls-Enter 7 rolls.
 - B. Fancy Yeast Products
8. Snacks-Enter 2 servings.
9. Brownies-Enter 10 brownies on a plate.

E. Food Preservation

Requirement-Must include a recipe card.

Note: All food preservation items may be opened for judging. All canned foods must be in canning jars and sealed. For safety, jar rings should still be on jars.

2. Pickles and Relishes-Boiling water bath processed
3. Fruits-Boiling water bath processed
4. Tomato products-Boiling water bath or pressure canned
5. Vegetables-Pressure canned
6. Dried foods



F. Flowers

Classes:

1. Container Plant (Flowering or Non-Flowering)
2. Dried Arrangement
3. Single Stem
 - Any variety with foliage exhibited in a suitable container
 - Label each flower
1. Fresh Arrangements
2. Artificial Arrangements
