This award is self-nominated (4-Her must apply).

1. Must be in grades 6 – 9 as of January 1.
2. Selection is based on: 50% Record of Achievement and 50% questions.
3. My Record of Achievement scoring will be:
 - a. Number of projects taken and completed – 10 points
 - b. Committee work – 10 points
 - c. Offices held – 10 points
 - d. Activities, workshops, meetings attended – 10 points
 - e. Community Service – 10 points
4. Five questions will be asked each year. Each question is worth 10 points. Each question should be answered in 4-5 sentences.
5. You may win this award one time.
6. Application deadline: Monday, May 1, 2023
There is a mail box in front of Extension Office to drop off.
7. Selection will be made by 3 judges – one 4-H Leader, one 4-H Council member and one 4-H Clubs, Inc. member.
8. Award winners will be contacted and will attend 4-H Awards Recognition Reception on Sunday, May 21, 2023. Winner will also be recognized during the Parade of Champions at the 4-H Fair.
9. The winner will be responsible for signing up and passing out awards at the Whitley County 4-H Fair
10. Submit a copy of all your “My Record of Achievement” forms, a cover page which has your name, club, grade, and shirt size, and the B.V. Widney Award application in a folder.
