OBJECTIVES

To learn how to start, add to, or continue a collection which is interesting, educational, and of some value – whether it be sentimental, intrinsic, or materialistic.

To learn how to tastefully display a collection.

EXHIBIT GUIDLINES

Exhibit one of the following:

- Poster – 22"x28"
 - Notebook or Album
 - Display: 2 feet deep by 2 feet wide on a table and not taller than 2 feet with notebook or album.
1. The Collections Project Inventory Sheet needs to be completed and must accompany the project exhibit.
 2. Failure to exhibit the inventory sheet will result in lowering the ribbon placing one grade – for example, blue to red.
 3. A new inventory sheet must be completed each year.
 4. The collection exhibited must be increased in size each year that it is exhibited.
 5. If the collection is of considerable value, it may be removed from the 4-H Center after judging with the consent of the Extension Educator. A photograph of the exhibit must be furnished for display.
 6. Any collection staying at the 4-H Fair must be displayed in a secured display to prevent removal of items from the display.
