

WHITLEY COUNTY BRED, BORN, AND RAISED (Administered by 4-H Clubs, Inc.)

GUIDELINES

1. Animals must be bred, born and raised in Whitley County to be eligible for the competition. The breeder who raised the animal must nominate it by the entry form deadline. Deadlines are as follows:
 - Beef, Junior Beef, Dairy Steers and Dairy Steer Feeder Calf: May 16th
 - Goat Wethers and Meat Market Does: May 16th
 - Swine Barrows and Gilts: May 16th
2. The nomination fee, payable by the breeder making the nomination must accompany the nomination form.
EXHIBIT: Each animal will be shown in the class which they normally would show in, broken down accordingly by breed, age, and/or weight. After the Grand Champion, Reserve Grand Champion, etc. have been selected, the highest placing Whitley County Bred, Born and Raised animal from each class will come back to compete for the Whitley County Bred, Born and Raised Champion and Reserve.
3. RECORD: No extra records will be required with the exception of the nomination form.
4. AUCTION: The Whitley County Bred, Born and Raised Grand Champion and the Reserve Grand Champion animals will sell following the Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion of their respective species.
