WHITLEY COUNTY BRED, BORN & RAISED

1. Only animals which have been bred, born and raised in Whitley County are eligible.
2. Animals must be nominated by their breeder in order to be eligible.
3. The nomination form is **NOT** complete unless it is accompanied by the nomination fee and required signatures. (*Youth Educator will sign form(s) at the Extension Office after they're turned in to the Livestock Club Leader*).
4. The Whitley County Bred, Born and Raised Champions will be selected following the Grand Champion drive in each respective show. (Example: Bred, Born and Raised Champion and Reserve Champion heifer will be selected following the Supreme Champion heifer drive from the highest placing Whitley County Bred, Born & Raised heifer in each class, providing the Supreme Champion and/or Reserve Supreme Champions are not eligible. The Bred, Born and Raised Champion and Reserve Champion Steer will be selected following the British Champion Steer).
5. The Whitley County Bred, Born and Raised Champion Beef and Dairy Steers will have the opportunity to sell in fourth position (following the Grand Champion, Reserve Grand Champion and the Rate of Gain Champion) in the auction. In all cases, the Reserve Champion Whitley County Bred, Born & Raised animals will have the opportunity to sell immediately following their respective Champion.
