



## WHITLEY COUNTY BRED, BORN & RAISED

1. Only animals which have been bred, born and raised in Whitley County are eligible.
2. Animals must be nominated by their breeder in order to be eligible.
3. Only wethers are eligible. There will be separate awards for dairy and meat-type wethers.
4. The nomination form is **NOT** complete unless it is accompanied by the nomination fee and required signatures. (*Youth Educator will sign form(s) at the Extension Office after they're turned in to the Livestock Club Leader*).
5. The Whitley County Bred, Born and Raised Champions will be selected following the Grand Champion drive. (Example: Bred, Born and Raised Champion and Reserve Champion Wether will be selected following the Supreme Champion Wether drive from the highest placing Whitley County Bred, Born & Raised wethers in each class, providing the Grand Champion and/or Reserve Grand Champions are not eligible.
6. The Whitley County Bred, Born and Raised Wether will have the opportunity to sell in the 4-H Livestock Auction (following the Grand and Reserve Grand Champions.) The Reserve Champion Whitley County Bred, Born and Raised animals will have the opportunity to sell immediately following their respective Champion.
7. Nomination fees are \$5.00 per wether. Fees are charged to defray the expenses incurred by this program and cover the costs of the awards. Fees are not intended to be utilized to fund other club projects or activities. Please make check payable to: Whitley County 4-H Goat Club
