


Logic Model

Co-Parenting for Successful Kids



Assumptions:

1. Parents are willing to make their child(ren)’s needs as first priority.
2. Parents are willing to make changes to their current attitudes and behaviors.
3. Parents realize that their child’s other parent is just as important to the child, and for the child’s emotional growth and development, as they are.
4. Parents that choose to take the program on-line will complete and submit the “homework”.
5. Parents that choose to take the program on-line have adequate computer skills.

Environment:

1. Cost of \$50 per participant.
2. Whether the parents attend the program as voluntary participants or are court-ordered.
3. Program is held in a location and at a time that is easily assessable to participants.
4. Participants that choose to take the program on-line have access to a computer and internet provider with enough broadband to access all the materials.
