



Social Media Tips and Reminders:

- Add pictures with your posts, if you have them, and feel free to use the Marq templates that have been created specifically for the Indiana State Fair.
- Don't be afraid to put an emoji or two in your post.
- Don't forget to use #PurdueExtension and tag @PurdueExtension, @HHS_Extension, @PurdueCDExt, and @Indiana4h when appropriate. If you are short on characters on X/Twitter, you can also tag in pictures. Note that handle names might be different on different platforms.
- Just copying and pasting the @___ will not automatically tag what was listed above. Make sure that it changes to the full-page name (Facebook and LinkedIn) or highlight the name in blue (Twitter). See examples below.
 - o For Facebook, to tag put @ then, without a space, start spelling the handle you want to use. Multiple handles pop up (as seen in the picture) but choose the one you want and it will look like the second picture. If the name turns blue and the @ disappears, you know you did it correctly.



o For X, the steps to tag will be very similar to Facebook. Start with the @ then, without a space, type in the desired handle (even if there are multiple words do not put the space in). Make sure you select the desired handle from the list that appears. If correct the @ and name will turn blue. Unlike Facebook, the @ symbol does not go away.



o For LinkedIn, put @ then immediately type in the desired handle. Unlike Facebook and X, if you do not write the handle exactly as desired, including spaces, you will not find what you're looking for. Once you find what you want, select it. The name you tagged will turn bold.
