Projects selected for State Fair

Letters were handed out during the awards ceremony at fair. If you missed the letter, we will be emailing them out again this week. For all projects except garden and foods, please drop your projects off to the extension office between July 21-25 from 8am to 4:30 pm. If you have a very large, heavy, or fragile exhibit, we ask that you transport it yourself. For cakes, models, floriculture, and other fragile exhibits, please feel free to package your project appropriately for transportation. If you have questions please reach out. The vehicle will be leaving at 9 am on July 28th.

<u>Food and garden items</u> can be dropped off to the office July 31st and August 1 during business hours and then on the 3rd between 4 and 6 pm. Canned, frozen, and preserved items can be dropped off the week prior but we recommend fresh products be dropped off morning of. If you plan to drop off on the 4th, please make sure you are here before 9:30 am!!! Please make sure a recipe card is attached. Rebecca will provide coolers for food items. If you plan to take your own food or garden project please email Rebecca. We will need to send you a parking pass.

*Please read the rules for your specific project to ensure all necessary sheets and components are attached. For example, if you completed a sewing project, you will need to attach a skills card. Failure to do so will result in points being deducted. If you have questions please feel free to reach out to the office.

All projects will be picked up on August 18th. You may come to the office starting August 19th to pick up your ribbons and projects. Please pick up all projects by August 29th!

STATE FAIR TICKETS

We have received state fair tickets in the office. Youth will have priority and will receive 2 tickets if they have a state fair entry. All approved adult volunteers are eligible for 1 ticket. Tickets can be picked up at the Extension Office During Business Hours.
