□ Exhibits checked-in Saturday, July 24 from 9am-12 noon, judging starts at 12:30 pm

An Allen County 4-H General Record Sheet must be completed, signed and turned in at the beginning of check-in for All Exhibit Building Projects.

BASIC CRAFTS

Any craft not included in fine arts, models or needlecraft is considered a basic craft. Hooked rugs, machine quilting, Latch Hook, Arm Knitting/Crocheting are basic crafts. Plastic canvas is considered a Basic Craft category. Kits may be used without penalty. See project sheet for examples.

EXHIBIT - Each 4-H'er may enter up to three (3) different project exhibits as long as they are all a *different type of craft*. An exhibit will consist of (1) One article, a related set, or a pair.
