

**Construction Sets
(No State Fair Entry)**

Level 1: Grades 3, 4, 5

Level 2: Grades 6, 7, 8

Level 3: Grades 9, 10, 11, 12

- Enroll in 4-H, pay annual program fee, and enter project in V2.4online by May 15
- Enter exhibit(s) in FairEntry by last business day in June, which is June 30, 2021. See Page 7 Rule #23.
- Exhibits checked-in Saturday, July 24 from 9am-12 noon, judging starts at 12:30 pm

An Allen County 4-H General Record Sheet must be completed, signed and turned in at the beginning of check-in for All Exhibit Building Projects.

4-H'er may exhibit 3 different Construction Sets.

Exhibits may be of any design and made with items such as Lego, K-Nex, Construx, Erector, Tinker Toys, Lincoln Logs, Duplo Blocks, Craft Sticks, etc. Blocks may be glued together, but is not mandatory.

Members should construct a more advanced project each year. Models will be judged on workmanship, appropriateness for age, creativity. Exhibit must rest on a sturdy base.

Exhibit Requirements:

Level 1: Grades 3, 4, 5

Construct a structure, construction set or character (animals, person, statue, etc). Kits are recommended in the Level 1, however not required.

Level 2: Grades 6, 7, 8

Design your own model, work on your creativity. Kits are not recommended for Level 2. Construct a structure, a scene, or some form of transportation (car, plane, train, etc.).

Level 3: Grades: 9, 10, 11, 12

Incorporate moveable or motorized parts in Level 3. Construct a structure (Tractor on a Farm, Space Shuttle with Lunar Module, Windmill and House, etc.)
