

**Arts and Crafts  
(State Fair Entry)**

- Enroll in 4-H, pay annual program fee, and enter project in V2.4honline by May 15
- Enter exhibit(s) in FairEntry by last business day in June, which is June 30, 2021. See page 7 Rule #23.
- Exhibits checked-in Saturday, July 24 from 9am-12 noon, judging starts at 12:30 pm

An Allen County 4-H General Record Sheet must be completed, signed and turned in at the beginning of check-in for All Exhibit Building Projects.

**Level 3: Grades 9, 10, 11, 12**

**FINE ARTS**

Only these mediums will be accepted in fine arts: oil, charcoal, pastels, ink, pencil, acrylic or water color on canvas, canvas board or paper, framed as a picture and prepared for hanging. Canvas art on a wooden frame is considered prepared for hanging provided that frame has a hanger.

**EXHIBIT** - Each 4-H'er may enter a maximum of three (3) different project exhibits as long as they are all a *different medium*. An exhibit will consist of: (1) One picture that is framed with a hanging device on back.
