- Enroll in 4-H, pay annual program fee, and enter project in V2.4honline by May 15
- Enter exhibit(s) in FairEntry by last business day in June, which is June 30, 2021. See page 7 Rule #23.
- Exhibits checked-in Saturday, July 24 from 9am-12 noon, judging starts at 12:30 pm

A specially designed program for Kindergarten, First & Second graders, as of January 1 of the current exhibition year, who desire to become involved with 4-H work.

Mini 4-H'ers will be allowed to enter a maximum of three (3) exhibits at the Fair. They will be on display, but will not be judged.

PURPOSE -

1. To teach younger children something about 4-H.
2. To encourage participation in 4-H when older.
3. To provide special 4-H projects helping them learn 4-H.

REQUIREMENTS:

1. You must be in Kindergarten, First or Second grade on January 1 of current exhibition year.
2. You must fill out enrollment sheet, which you will return to your leader.
3. You may or may not attend your local 4-H meetings. (It is up to your leader.)
4. You do not have to keep records, although it is recommended.
5. There is no State Fair Exhibit.
6. Turn in blue accumulated record sheet at the Fair; however, points will not accumulate until the 3rd grade.
7. See Allen County General 4-H Rules: Label Rule.
