

Models
(State Fair Entry)

- Enroll in 4-H, pay annual program fee, and enter project in V2.4online by May 15
- Enter exhibit(s) in FairEntry by last business day in June, which is June 30, 2021. See page 7 Rule #23.
- Exhibits checked-in Saturday, July 24 from 9am-12 noon, judging starts at 12:30 pm

An Allen County 4-H General Record Sheet must be completed, signed and turned in at the beginning of check-in for All Exhibit Building Projects.

Level 1: Grades 3, 4, 5

Level 2: Grades 6, 7, 8

Level 3: Grades 9, 10, 11, 12

MODELS

Exhibits must be a small scale replica and meet the following criteria:

Must be of injected styrene plastics

At least 25% of the exhibit must be painted

Wood, paper, clay, die-cast, or snap together models are not permitted

Screws are not permitted

Pre-painted or pre-decaled factory models are not permitted

Legos are not considered models and are to be exhibited as a Construction Set. If model is being build from a kit, include a copy of the Instructions with the craft information card.

EXHIBIT - Each 4-H'ers may enter a maximum of three (3) different project exhibits as long as they are all a *different material*. An exhibit will consist of: (1) Your best constructed model. The model must be displayed on some type of display board for stability and security.
