

**Arts and Crafts
(State Fair Entry)**

- Enroll in 4-H, pay annual program fee, and enter project in V2.4honline by May 15
- Enter exhibit(s) in FairEntry by last business day in June, which is June 30, 2021. See page 7 Rule #23.
- Exhibits checked-in Saturday, July 24 from 9am-12 noon, judging starts at 12:30 pm

An Allen County 4-H General Record Sheet must be completed, signed and turned in at the beginning of check-in for All Exhibit Building Projects.

Level 1: Grades 3, 4, 5

Level 2: Grades 6, 7, 8

Level 3: Grades 9, 10, 11, 12

NEEDLECRAFT

Only these crafts will be accepted in needlecraft: knitting, embroidery, crocheting, needlepoint, crewel, candle wicking, chicken scratching, hand quilting, tatting, huck embroidery, hemstitching,; also pulled, drawn and counted thread work and punch needle works. Does not include latch hook, plastic canvas, machine knitting, machine quilting or arm knitting/crocheting.

EXHIBIT - Each 4-H'er may enter a maximum of three (3) different project exhibits as long as they are all a *different type of needlecraft*. An exhibit will consist of: (1) One article, a pair or a set.
