

**Outdoor Cooking
(No State Fair Exhibit)**

- Enroll in 4-H, pay annual program fee, and enter project in V2.4honline by May 15
- Enter exhibit(s) in FairEntry by last business day in June, which is June 30, 2021. See page 7 Rule #23.
- Exhibits checked-in Saturday, July 24 from 9am-12 noon, judging starts at 12:30 pm

An Allen County 4-H General Record Sheet must be completed, signed and turned in at the beginning of check-in for All Exhibit Building Projects.

Level 1: Grades 3-4-5

Level 2: Grades 6-7-8

Level 3: Grades 9-10-11-12

All exhibits must include a reference list indicating where information was obtained, giving credit to the original author when using outside sources. This reference list should/might include website links, people and professionals interviewed, books, magazines, etc. This reference list may be attached to the back of a poster or display board, be the last page of a notebook, or included as part of the display visible to the public. A judge is not to discredit an exhibit for the manner in which references are listed.

Methods of outdoor cooking include, but are not limited to, stick cooking, grilling, foil packets, dutch oven, smoking, spit, skillet or griddle cooking.

Level 1 Grades 3-4-5

Exhibit a 22 x 28 inch poster showing you cooking an entrée and a side dish outdoors that includes a menu.

Level 2 Grades 6-7-8

Exhibit a 22 x 28 inch poster showing you cooking an entrée and a side dish, and a dessert outdoors that includes your menu.

Level 3 Grades 9-10-11-12

Exhibit a 22 x 28 inch poster showing you cooking an appetizer, an entrée and a side dish, and a dessert outdoors that includes your menu.
