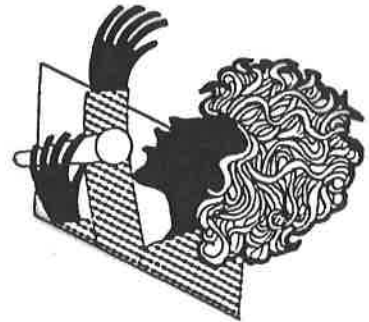
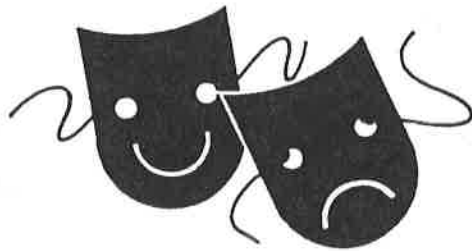

PERFORMING ARTS

Objective: To encourage youth to explore the areas of performing arts; to develop an appreciation for these art forms; to become cognizant of those who participate in these forms of expression, and to have the opportunity for an appraisal of the members skill in a particular art.

Areas of Performing Arts: Solo Performance, Music - Vocal and Instrumental, Dance - all forms, Drama.

Requirements:

Your Manual will be returned to you. You will need to keep this manual in a notebook. You are to add to it each year you perform so the judge can see how you have improved and advanced.

If your performance requires an accompanist you may include such accompanist, however, their performance will not be judged.
