Dear member of the 4-H Food Project,

Important 4-H Food Project Information

If you would like to sell a Foods project in the Foods Auction on Monday night, July 13 7:30 p.m. you need to read this!

Due to the changes in the new 4-H Foods Exhibits - we are asking members to bring a SEPARATE foods item for the auction to check-in/judging on Monday morning, July 13 from 8 - 8:30 a.m.

See the rules for complete details. This is just a summary. You must have a recipe card for your project.

All plates should be disposable. You will NOT get them back.

Grade 3: Exhibit: 3 snack-sized cookies. Auction: 12 cookies (on a plate and covered).

Grade 4: Exhibit: 3 muffins. Auction: 6 muffins (on a plate and covered).

Grade 5: Exhibit: 1 layer cake. Auction: 1 layer cake (on a plate and covered). No icing on either.

Grade 6: Exhibit: 3 no-yeast pretzels or 3 no-yeast biscuits. Auction: 6 pretzels or biscuits (on a plate and covered).

Grade 7, 8, 9: Exhibit: 3 yeast pretzels or 3 yeast rolls. Auction: 6 pretzels or rolls (on a plate and covered).

OR

Grade 7, 8, 9: Exhibit: 1 yeast bread. Auction: 1 yeast bread (on a plate and covered). OR

Grade 7, 8, 9: Exhibit: 1 package invented snack. Auction: 1 large package or several small packages of invented snack.

Grade 10, 11, 12: Exhibit: A single or double crust pie. Auction: A single or double crust pie. OR

Grade 10, 11, 12: Exhibit: A non-perishable baked food product with notebook/display.

Auction: A non-perishable baked food product (on a plate and covered). NO Notebook/Display.

OR

Grade 10, 11, 12: Exhibit: A non-perishable baked food product with notebook. Auction: A non-perishable baked food product (on a plate and covered). NO Notebook.

If you have questions - please ask!!!

Also remember to sign up to attend a workshop on either June 18 or June 24. Call or email the Extension Office.

If you cannot attend a workshop - you need to ask for a record sheet. The record sheet will be completed to exhibit. You can bring one of your practice exhibits to the workshop and we will "judge" it. Remember to bring the recipe. We will give you ideas and suggestions on your exhibit.

Remember you do not have to participate in the 4-H Foods Auction - but if you want to - you will have to bring a separate item for the auction. Place your NAME and GRADE in School (as of January 1, 2015) on your auction entry.

We will have an exhibit card for your food - if you entered in Fair Entry.
