



2021 Boone Co 4-H Fair Virtual Exhibits

While it is understood pictures and videos cannot fully replace live exhibits the virtual fair environment is intended to allow a judge to see and learn about the skills a 4-H member has developed throughout this past year resulting from their 4-H experiences. Refer to the 2021 Boone County 4-H Handbook for all info on each projects. Once you have looked through this list of virtual project requirements for submitting a virtual project please go to <https://extension.purdue.edu/boone/article/37428> and there you will find resources for uploading necessary documents to Fair Entry.

A few minor exceptions are being made to static exhibit requirements submitted virtually.

- a. All Projects – Providing a reference list is not required.
- b. Posters – Sleeves and hard backing are not required as exhibits will not be displayed and plastic sleeves will cause a glare when photographing.
- c. Fine Arts – Having exhibits suitable for hanging is not required as exhibits will not be displayed at a fair for public viewing.
- d. Photography Salon Prints – Photos may be uploaded directly to FairEntry. Mounting on a salon board is optional since the exhibit will not be displayed for public viewing.

Record Sheet, Manual Activities, Worksheets & Alternative Activity Forms:

Upload this paperwork along with project images if you plan to only show virtually. If you plan to exhibit in person then you can just bring this paperwork in person to the fair. Paperwork can be uploaded as a jpg, png, tiff, PDF, Word, Power Point, or excel. If you are in dog, poultry and/or photography then you were given the opportunity to participate in activities instead of completing activities in the project manual. If you did this then you will submit the Alternative Activity Form and the record sheet through FairEntry. This new form is on the project webpage.

Animal projects (judged during the fair): June 11- July 9

Foods, Baked	Cake	Plate the cake for display and remove one slice from the edge to the center. On a small dessert type plate place the removed slice upside down showing the bottom. Take the photo in a well-lit area of the plated cake and plated slice together in one photo. Try to reduce as many shadows and glares as possible. Be sure the entire exhibit is visible in the photo. The recipe card will be a second upload.
Foods, Baked	No-Yeast Pretzels or No-Yeast Biscuits	Three baked pretzels or biscuits are to be plated; two right-side up and the third upside-down and broken in half showing the inside and bottom. Take the photo in a well-lit area. Try to reduce as many shadows and glares as possible. Be sure the entire exhibit is visible in the photo. The recipe card will be a second upload.
Foods, Baked	Yeast Bread Sticks or Rolls	Three baked bread sticks or rolls are to be plated; two right-side up and the third upside-down and broken in half showing the inside and bottom. Take the photo in a well-lit area. Try to reduce as many shadows and glares as possible. Be sure the entire exhibit is visible in the photo. The recipe card will be a second upload.
Foods, Baked	Yeast Bread Loaf	Slice the loaf of bread in half at its middle plating one half right-side up and the other half upside-down showing its middle and the bottom crust. Take the photo in a well-lit area. Try to reduce as many shadows and glares as possible. Be sure the entire exhibit is visible in the photo. The recipe card will be a second upload.
Foods, Baked	Invented Healthy Snack	Take the photo showing the entire exhibit in a well-lit area. Try to reduce as many shadows and glares as possible.
