### **PROJECT DESCRIPTION:**

As you advance in the project, you will learn to become a dependable and responsible babysitter.

### Exhibit:

- 1. Choose one activity that you completed in this level. Design a 22" x 28" poster or a three-ring binder notebook that reflects what you did with this activity. Or,
- Create a display no larger than 36" x 36" x 36" using one of the activities from your project manual. <u>Complete an Activity Card and attach it to the exhibit. A Sample Activity Card is in your project book. Use a 5" x 8" index card or larger cardstock to create your card.</u> A display can be poster, tri-fold educational, and / or game / toy type.

NOTE: For level C & D, your activity can come from the manual or be an activity that promotes physical, emotional or cognitive skills.

### All Posters, Notebooks and Display Boards

All posters, notebooks, and display boards <u>must</u> include a reference list indicating where information was obtained, giving credit to the original author, to complete the 4-H member's exhibit. This reference list should/might include web site links, people and professionals interviewed, books, magazines, etc. It is recommended this reference list be attached to the back of a poster or display board, be the last page of a notebook, or included as part of the display visible to the public. A judge is not to discredit an exhibit for the manner in which references are listed.

### Binder / Notebook Requirements:

- 1. Identification label on front of the binder/notebook giving name of 4-H'er, club, grade and year in project.
- 2. Title page inside binder/notebook naming activity.
- 3. Pages of activity and explanation to follow title page.
- 4. Photographs are helpful to show the activity being used or assembled.
- 5. Optional: Plastic sheet protectors, page decorations, binder cover decoration, etc.
- 6. If possible, add a label to the binder spine (outside edge). The label should include 4-H'er name, project name and county.

### **Display Requirements:**

- May be table top or floor style display, not to exceed 36" x 36" x 36". (Display may include item(s) made in the activities you completed this year.) A display can be poster, tri-folder educational, and/or game/toy type with accompanying activity card.
- 2. Must be self-supporting to be viewed by the public.

### Poster Requirements:

1. Poster exhibits should have the standardized exhibit card in the lower right hand corner with the 4-H member's name, project and club. You should allow room on your poster for the exhibit card

(Height -  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x Width –  $4\frac{1}{4}$ "). The exhibit card will be available at check-in time at the fair. NOTE: Add your name, club and the date poster was completed in the bottom right corner in permanent ink under the plastic, where the exhibitor card will cover.

- 2. Posters must be 22" x 28" and DISPLAYED HORIZONTALLY and not vertically .
- 3. POSTER MUST BE SELF-SUPPORTING (remain standing when leaned at a slight angle). Use heavy cardboard, foam board, or pegboard for stiffness.
- 4. All posters must be covered with clear plastic.
