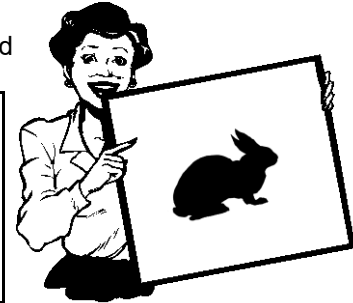


Communications: RABBIT or POULTRY ILLUSTRATED TALK

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

In a Rabbit or Poultry Illustrated Talk you will talk about something regarding your rabbit or poultry project. You tell or explain about the topic with the use of visual aids. You create no finished product in an Illustrated Talk (unlike a Demonstration).

EXHIBIT:

1. Each 4-H Rabbit Illustrated Talk should be original and of a practical nature related to some phase of the rabbit industry. Elaborate and expensive equipment cannot be justified.
2. The Illustrated Talk should last 5 to 7 minutes. Judges will deduct points when the presentation exceeds the maximum minutes "allowed".
3. The illustrated talk topic should be related to the project while using props and/or a PowerPoint, Prezi, or other digital presentation.
4. Grade will be determined as of March 1 of current year.
5. All county participants are eligible to compete at the State Fair.
