Topic Suggestions: NOTE: The subject matter content **MUST** correspond to the subject matter found in your current project book or project books for levels below you.

- **Level A** pre-operational checklist, gas or diesel fuel, parts of a tractor, caring for your tractor, tractor safety, hazard alerts
- <u>Level B</u> mower or conveyor safety, hand signal, hitching implements, multi-faces of oil, types of air filters

Level C tractor care such as batteries or tire pressure, fuel safety, hydraulics, tillage equipment

Level D towing safety, winterization, lubing your tractor, planters or sprayers

Poster Requirements:

- 1. Poster exhibits should have the standardized exhibit card in the lower right hand corner with the 4-H member's name, project and club. You should allow room on your poster for the exhibit card (Height $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x Width $4\frac{1}{4}$ "). The exhibit card will be available at check-in time at the fair. NOTE: Add your name, club and the date poster was completed in the bottom right corner in permanent ink under the plastic, where the exhibitor card will cover.
- 2. Posters must be 22" x 28" and DISPLAYED HORIZONTALLY and not vertically ■.
- 3. POSTER MUST BE SELF-SUPPORTING (remain standing when leaned at a slight angle). Use heavy cardboard, foam board, or pegboard for stiffness. For sources of heavy cardboard, contact the Extension Office.
- 4. All posters must be covered with clear plastic.
- 5. All posters, notebooks, and display boards <u>must</u> include a reference list indicating where information was obtained, giving credit to the original author, to complete the 4-H member's exhibit. This reference list should/might include web site links, people and professionals interviewed, books, magazines, etc. It is recommended this reference list be attached to the back of a poster or display board, be the last page of a notebook, or included as part of the display visible to the public. A judge is not to discredit an exhibit for the manner in which references are listed.
