Cattle Tag Day February 25th @ 9 AM to Noon

The 2023 Clay County 4-H Beef Tagging Day will be held in the Cattle Barn on the morning of Saturday February 25th. Tag-in Day for all beef steers, dairy steers and commercial (crossbred) heifers is required.



In addition, if you have registered percentage heifers that you plan to exhibit at the State Fair, you should bring those heifers to tag-in as well. For this year, 4-H'ers will be charged \$3.00 for RFID tags and \$3.00 for any county tags needed at tag-in. You can pay by check or cash. Checks can be made payable to the Clay County 4-H Cattle Club.

Middle School Night Out February 25h @ 4 to 9 PM



Indiana 4-H Quality Livestock Care @ 6:30 PM in the Exhibit Hall

All Livestock Exhibitors must complete the Indiana 4-H Quality Livestock Care training. This is a new program that is replacing the previous Youth for the Quality Assurance Program or YQCA. This program is currently only offered inperson, thanks to the sponsorship of Clay County Farm Bureau, this is <u>FREE!</u> If you are not able to attend one of the in-person trainings, the YQCA online program will fill the requirement for the quality care training. This can be done at <u>yqcaprogram.org</u>. If you complete it online, you MUST provide your certificate to the Extension Office (email korniak@purdue.edu or bring it in during office hours Monday-Friday 8 am to 4 pm).

The trainings are scheduled for March 27th, April 27th, May 23rd, and June 21st
