GET YOUR STATE APPROVED POSTER BOARD AND SLEEVES AT THE EXTENSION OFFICE!

We are offering foam core poster boards for \$3 and clear plastic covers for \$1. The clear plastic covers are designed like an envelope where you simply slip your foam core poster inside and seal it with its own self-adhesive strip.

Just a couple of things to keep in mind: All posters, notebooks, and display boards must include a reference list indicating where information was obtained and giving credit to the original author. This reference list should/might include web site links, people and professionals interviewed, books, magazines, etc. It is required for the reference list be attached to the back of a poster or display board, be the last page of a notebook, or included as part of the display visible to the public. A judge is not to discredit an exhibit for the manner in which references are listed. Make sure to carefully review the project requirements prior to the fair. These can be found on our county website (extension.purdue.edu/clay) or in the Extension Office.

LIVESTOCK INFORMATION & DEADLINES



All Livestock Exhibitors (Cattle, Poultry, Sheep, Goats, Swine & Rabbit) must complete the Indiana 4-H Quality Livestock Care (QLC) training. This is a new program that is replacing the previous Youth for the Quality Assurance Program or YQCA. This program is currently only offered inperson, thanks to the sponsorship of Clay County Farm Bureau, this is FREE! If you are not able to attend one of the in-person trainings, the YQCA online program will fill the requirement for the quality care training. This can be done at yqcaprogram.org. If you complete it online, you MUST provide your certificate to the Extension Office (email korniak@purdue.edu or bring it in during office hours Monday-Friday 8 am to 4 pm).

The trainings are scheduled for <u>April 27th, May 23rd, and June 21st</u> at 6:30 pm in the Exhibit Hall.

DEADLINE TO ADD ANIMAL INFORMATION INTO 4-H ONLINE

- MAY 15, 2023

May 15th is the deadline to enroll all your animals (Horses, Cattle, Sheep, Swine, Goats, and Rabbits)* into 4-H Online. In order to be eligible to show at the fair, this step must be completed! Refer to the livestock packet you should have received in the mail for instructions. If you did not receive a packet or have questions on this, please contact the Extension Office. After May 15 we will not be able to add animals, making them ineligible to show, so please don't hesitate to get them registered!

*Poultry will be registered by paper form this year, due June 24th.

STATE FAIR DNA - MAY 15

If you are planning on exhibiting swine, beef or dairy cattle, sheep or meat goats at the Indiana State Fair, you are required to submit a DNA hair sample to the Extension Office by May 15. DNA envelopes can be obtained at the office or on tag day.

CATTLE, SHEEP & GOAT TAG DAY - MAY 6, 2023 9AM - NOON

On May 6th from 9 am to Noon at the Fairgrounds, bring your animals in order to get their proper identification. All tags will be \$3.00. Refer to your livestock letters you should have received in the mail for what animals you need to bring.

SWINE RFID TAGS

*NEW THIS YEAR

All swine must be assigned an 840-RFID ear tag to be eligible to show at the Clay County & State Fair. These tags can be purchased at the Extension Office or at Swine club meetings for \$3.00. You will need to enter the assigned 840 number for each animal when you identify them on 4HOnline by May 15. There will not be a swine tag day, if you need assistance in tagging please call the Extension Office & we can put in contact with someone who can assist.

CLAY COUNTY BEEF & SWINE OPEN SHOW OPPORTUNITIES

On April 22nd the cattle club will be hosting an open show. The show starts at 11 am with check in beginning Friday from 6 to 8 pm and Saturday from 7 to 9 am. Entry Fee is \$45 a head. Our Swine Club will be hosting their open show on June 3rd with more details to come. Both shows offer a great opportunity to get experience in our show ring and practice with your animals. Help spread the word to surrounding counties & extend an invite to attend!
