It is scheduled for Saturday, February 12th at Cloverdale High School from 8:15 am to 2 pm.

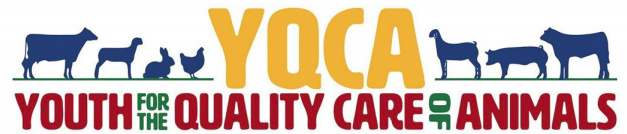

February 25-27, 2022

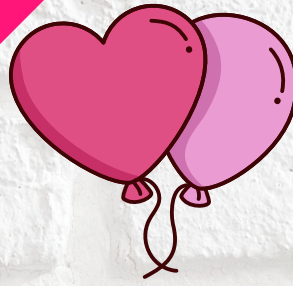

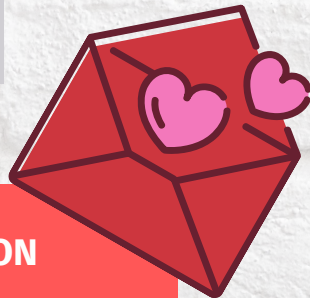
