

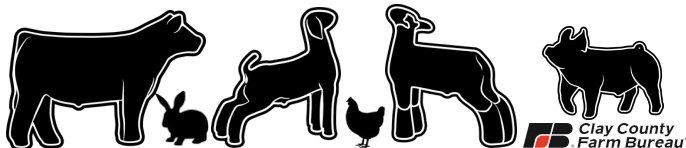


WELCOME

Indiana 4-H Quality Livestock Care



All Livestock Exhibitors (Cattle, Poultry, Sheep, Goats, Swine & Rabbit) MUST complete the Indiana 4-H Quality Livestock Care (QLC) training in order to unload their animals at fair.


This is a new program that is replacing the previous Youth for the Quality Assurance Program or YQCA. This program is currently only offered in-person, thanks to the sponsorship of Clay County Farm Bureau, this is FREE! If you are not able to attend one of the in-person trainings, the YQCA online program will fill the requirement for the quality care training. This can be done at yqcaprogram.org. If you complete it online, you MUST provide your certificate to the Extension Office (email korniak@purdue.edu) or bring it in during office hours Monday-Friday 8 am to 4 pm).

FINAL TRAINING IS ON JUNE 21 @ 6:30 pm in the Exhibit Hall. Please call the Extension Office to RSVP your spot.

FAIR ENTRY IS NOW OPEN UNTIL **JULY 1ST!**

All 4-H members (including Minis) should go online to <http://claycountyindiana.fairentry.com/> and enter details for each project they wish to bring to the Fair. This includes livestock and non-livestock projects. The information entered will be used to create judging sheets, fair results, show programs, etc. For livestock members, you will select which classes you wish to participate in. You may need to go through this multiple times if you plan to show several different animals or if you plan to show the same animal in multiple classes. Detailed instructions for FairEntry are listed below. If you need help in completing entries, please contact or come to the Extension Office for assistance.

1. Go to <http://claycountyindiana.fairentry.com>
2. Select "Sign in with your 4-H Online account" (green box)
3. Enter your login email address and password from 4Honline. If you do not remember your password select "I forgot my password" and a temporary one will be emailed to you.
4. Click the "Login box". This will take you to the Welcome screen, where you select "Begin registration".
5. Choose register an exhibitor and click on "individual".
6. Choose the dot next to the name of the 4-H member you would like to register and click continue. DO NOT CREATE AN EXHIBITOR FROM SCRATCH
7. Answer any required questions (not everyone will have required questions) and review your information. Then the click continue button.
8. Next, click on "Continue to Entries" button.
9. Click "Add an Entry" box to right of name.
10. Click on "Select" button next to the Department you would like to enter. State Gardening contains gardening. State Projects contains all projects that go to state fair and tractor driving, demonstrations, fashion revue. If it is County Only project or event, it is under County Only.
11. Mini 4-H and animals are under the individual departments.
12. Click the "Select" button next to the Class you would like to enter. (Check the Clay County Terms and Conditions 4-H Handbook for exhibit descriptions, requirements and rules.)
13. Review your selection, then click create entry or continue.
14. Enter a description of your exhibit and then click continue.
15. Enter the 4-H Club that goes with project.
16. If this is an animal project, you will have to select an animal. Choose from existing animals if cattle, horse, sheep, goats, rabbits or swine. Cats, dogs, poultry and pet animals will select enter a NEW ANIMAL RECORD.
17. After you have completed all of your entries, you will enter the payment section. THERE IS NO CHARGE, select continue.

Once you are sure all your entries are entered CLICK THE SUBMIT button. YOU WILL RECEIVE A THANKS! Message once you submit. You will not be able to add any more entries until the submitted ones are approved in the office. You will also receive an email from Fair Entry letting you know if your entry is approved or rejected by the county staff. If it is rejected, a reason will be listed and you will be able to login and fix the problem. Please contact the Extension Office at 812-448-9041 if you have problems with this process.



WHEN DO I BRING MY PROJECT IN FOR JUDGING?

We will be utilizing open judging for all projects. This allows the 4-H members to meet with the judge and be able to describe their projects. This year we have changed the start time for both judging days to 5 pm in hopes of allowing more time for families after work. Please make sure you plan to bring the correct project on the correct day. If you should have a scheduling conflict, please let the Extension Office know & we will try to accommodate.

2023 CLAY COUNTY 4-H LIVESTOCK AUCTION

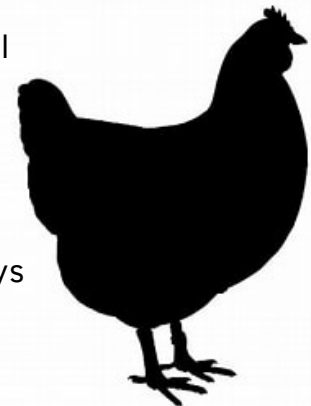
On Friday evening July 21st at 6 pm we will be having a live animal livestock auction in the show arena. Exhibitors in rabbit, poultry, sheep, meat goat, swine, beef and dairy will have the opportunity to designate an eligible market animal to auction off. We encourage you to reach out to community members and businesses to come out and support the auction by purchasing yours or other members animals. There will be a free meal for those registered buyers prior to the auction.

On Saturday evening July 22nd at 6 pm we will be having a 4-H Benefit and Celebration Dinner in the Exhibit Hall. This will be similar to the Benefit for the Barns event that has been held in place of the auction the last 2 years. Buyers will have the option to come in and donate money to any of the 4-H'ers who participated in the livestock auction on Friday evening. There will be a tack auction to help raise money for our youth as well. This night is mostly to CELEBRATE all the hard work that 4-H'ers have completed during fair week and throughout the year! We will specifically be highlighting all of our seniors and those in attendance will receive scholarship funds. All 4-H'ers in the Clay County 4-H Program, including non-livestock members, will eat free at the 4-H benefit thanks to the sponsorship of First Farmers Bank and Trust. Hope you are able to CELEBRATE with us!

POULTRY BLOOD TESTING- JUNE 13 & JUNE 24

In 1981 Indiana became an official U.S. Pullorum-Typhoid clean state. To maintain this classification, all poultry (excluding waterfowl & pigeons) going to the county fair must be officially blood tested.

Blood testing will be offered after the club meeting on June 13th being held at 7 pm at the fairgrounds. It will also be offered on the morning of Saturday, June 24th at the Clay County 4-H Fairgrounds Poultry Barn from 9-11 am. The cost for testing is to be determined, but is expected to be about \$1 per animal. These will be the only days that blood testing is offered. Please make arrangements to attend!



Your final poultry entry forms will need to be turned into the Extension Office by June 24th. Those forms can be found [here](#) or at the Extension Office.

2023 INDIANA 4-H APPROVED ANIMAL GROOMING PROGRAM

If you plan to have someone other than an immediate family member or another Indiana 4-H member help with grooming or assist in caring for your animal during the Clay County Fair and/or the Indiana State Fair, then they will need to go to the link below to complete the process & be approved by July 1, 2023. [Qualtrics Survey | Qualtrics Experience Management](#)

A couple of key points and reminders:

- Applicants must complete the process annually by July 1 in order to help at the county fair.
- If someone is an approved 4-H Volunteer, that does not mean they are in this program automatically.
- This process must be completed annually and is only for those with a valid Indiana Driver's License.
- A report will be kept on hand with all approved groomers listed.
- Once enrolled in the program, you will be able to assist any 4-H member from any county on any animal species.
- This process works best on a desktop computer.

Working on your posters yet?

GET YOUR STATE APPROVED POSTER BOARD AND SLEEVES AT THE EXTENSION OFFICE!

We are offering foam core poster boards for \$3 and clear plastic covers for \$1. The clear plastic covers are designed like an envelope where you simply slip your foam core poster inside and seal it with its own self-adhesive strip.

Just a couple of things to keep in mind: All posters, notebooks, and display boards must include a reference list indicating where information was obtained and giving credit to the original author. This reference list should/might include web site links, people and professionals interviewed, books, magazines, etc. It is required for the reference list be attached to the back of a poster or display board, be the last page of a notebook, or included as part of the display visible to the public. A judge is not to discredit an exhibit for the manner in which references are listed. Make sure to carefully review the project requirements prior to the fair. These can be found on our county website (extension.purdue.edu/clay) or in the Extension Office.
