



# **CUPCAKE DECORATING**

(2023 Clay County Project)

## **Exhibit Guidelines:**

- All projects must be on a solid display board such as cardboard or wood. All displays boards must measure 3 to 4 inches larger than the cupcake display. Boards should be covered.
- Icing must be used in your project; however, artificial items may also be used.
- Items that are edible must be attached naturally; artificial items may be attached to your display using glue, wire, etc.
- You may use Styrofoam cupcake forms to decorate.

# Exhibit Class Guidelines:

- <u>Beginner (grades 3-5)</u>
  - Display 6-12 individually decorated cupcakes, decorated in a theme.
  - Cupcakes **must** be displayed in a single layer, on a solid display board.
  - Your cupcake display area must not exceed an 18" x 18" x 18" display area. No matter the display, your cupcake project must be presented on a solid display board.
- Intermediate (grades 6-8)
  - Display 12-18 cupcakes, decorated in a theme.
  - Cupcakes may be decorated individually or as a group, as long as the theme is carried out in your display.
  - Your cupcake display area must not exceed a 24" x 24" x 24" display area. No matter your display, your cupcake project **must** be presented on a solid display board.

#### • Advanced (grades 9-12)

- Display 18 or more cupcakes, decorated in a theme.
- Cupcakes may be decorated individually or as a group, as long as the theme is carried out in your display.
- Your cupcake display area must not exceed a 36" x 36" x 36" display area. No matter your display, your cupcake project **must** be presented on a solid display board.
