I. CRITERIA

- a. Applications will be accepted from any Clinton County high school senior or adult furthering his/her education. Preference will be given to applicants applying with majors selected from the attached list.
- b. All applicants must be a Clinton County resident for at least one year and be accepted or currently enrolled at an Indiana accredited post-secondary institution, as a full-time student (12 credit hours) for the 2023 - 2024 school year.
- c. Preference will be given to a Clinton County Extension Homemaker, or Homemaker's child, grandchild or great grandchild.
- d. The \$500 award will be made payable to the institution in which the applicant is enrolled.

II. INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING APPLICATION

- a. Applications can be found online at: <http://purdue.edu/extension/clinton>, from the four county schools' guidance counselors or from the Purdue Extension Office.
- b. Please type or print clearly when filling out the application.
- c. Include two recommendation letters, using the form attached.
- d. Include a copy of the College/School acceptance letter.
- e. Include the biographical information including school, church, community or other activities; financial need, or any other special circumstances to be considered.
- f. Include a certified (signed) copy of your high school transcript.
- g. A certificate will be presented to the scholarship recipient at their high school spring awards ceremony, if applicable, and s/he will be expected to attend the Clinton County Extension Homemakers Achievement Night in late May, to be recognized.
- h. Instruction non-compliance will invalidate the application.
- i. The Scholarship Committee of the Clinton County Extension Homemakers will select the award recipient.
