4-H Foundation Senior Year Scholarship

- ◆ Must be a high school senior

Indiana 4-H Accomplishment

- ◆ This scholarship is to recognize youth who have excelled in life skills development through their 4-H activities and involvement. Categories include Animal Science ((Meat and Milk Production) and (Companion and Small Animal Production)); Citizenship; Communications; Engineering and Technological Science; Healthy Living, Food and Nutrition Science; Leadership Development; and Plant and Environmental Science.
- ◆ Must be in 10th, 11th or 12th grade or the year immediately following high school graduation at the time applications are due. While an applicant does not have to be a current 4-H member, they must demonstrate multiple years of involvement in Indiana's 4-H Youth Development Program

State 4-H Club Scholarships

- ◆ Pursue studies in: College of Ag or select majors in college of Health & Human Sciences; Apparel Design and Technology, Dietetics, Developmental and Family Science, Early Childhood Education and Exceptional Needs, Family and Consumer Sciences Education, Environmental Health Science, Financial Counseling and Science, Retail Management, or Selling and Sales Management.

Laurenz Greene Memorial 4-H Horticulture Scholarship

- ◆ \$1,000 award per year, renewable for 4 years.
- ◆ Must be in 12th grade (at time of due date)
- ◆ Must be planning to pursue a Purdue University Department of Horticulture and Landscape Architecture undergraduate degree.

Purdue Horticulture and Landscape Architecture Scholarship

- ◆ Available to a 4-H member majoring in horticulture or landscape architecture at Purdue University and studied plant science in 4-H.

Amick Loan

- ◆ Must contact Indiana 4-H Foundation (317)692-7044 for application
- ◆ Must be a high school junior or senior enrolled at Purdue who have completed a minimum of 2 years of 4-H membership and have a minimum GPA of 2.5
- ◆ Must be taking classes on campus in order to apply for loan

Chad Holtkamp Memorial Award

- ◆ Must be planning some post-high school studies or training (Doesn't have to be in Indiana)
- ◆ Savings Bond amount decided by family
- ◆ Applications are available at the Extension Office or online at www.extension.purdue.edu/decatur

Tree City Saddle Club Award

- ◆ Must be planning some post-high school studies or training at an accredited college or university (Doesn't have to be in Indiana) on Equine, Veterinarian and Vet. Tech. or Agriculture Industry
- ◆ Award will be paid directly to the school
- ◆ See application for criteria used in selecting the recipient

Attie M. Austin Memorial Scholarship & Steve Hunter Memorial Scholarship

* Students seeking vocational training

Bob Clark Memorial Scholarship

* Student pursuing a 2 or 4 year degree in criminology or law enforcement.

Roland Curtis and Willa Marie Barnes Nursing Scholarship; Roscoe Family Scholarship (South Decatur); & Bonnie Springmeyer Nursing Scholarship

* Student pursuing a 2 or 4 year degree in nursing.

Joanie Bostic Memorial Senior Pirate Spirit Award

* Scholarship recognizes a senior who shows outstanding school spirit by participation in or support of athletics or music.

Rev. Robert L. Browning Memorial Fund

- * This memorial fund is given annually to any student from Decatur County seeking a career in the ministry or a social or human service organization or a student planning on attending Anderson University.

Holly Bruns Memorial Scholarship

- * This scholarship is for a graduating senior from South Decatur pursuing post-secondary education at Marian University, who played volleyball or softball.
- * In the event that the above criteria are too restrictive, the scholarship would be awarded to a South Decatur student pursuing a degree in the field of education, who most closely fits the above criteria in the order of preference.

Clifford Byard Memorial Scholarship

- * This scholarship is for any graduate of South Decatur pursuing a 2 or 4 year degree in engineering, music or education.

J-N-J Chapman Scholarship

- * This scholarship is for seniors of North or South Decatur that are seeking vocational training or an associates degree at an accredited 2 or 4 year program.

Stewart G. Corya Purdue University Engineering Scholarship

- * This scholarship is for a student graduating in the top 15% of their class and will be seeking an engineering degree at Purdue.

Thelma E. Corya Indiana University Kelley School of Business Scholarship

- * This scholarship is for a student graduating in the top 10% of their class or has obtained a GPA of 3.50 or higher, and will be attending IU Kelley School of Business or any other Kelley School of Business campus.

Danny W. Dieckmann Memorial Scholarship & Clifford "Skip" Ricke Memorial Scholarship

- * This scholarship is to help any student that is graduating or has graduated from North Decatur and is pursuing

a 2 or 4 year degree in Agriculture or a related field of study.

Arnold D. Ducanes, MD Scholarship

- * This scholarship is to help students seeking training in the field of Allied Health.

Martha L. Frost Scholarship

- * This scholarship is open to graduating Greensburg High School students pursuing a degree in Art.

GCHS Class of 1961 Scholarship

- * This scholarship is to support the 61st student in the Greensburg High School graduating class pursuing a degree at a 2 or 4 year institution.

Joyce J. Green Scholarship

- * This scholarship is to help a graduating senior from Greensburg High School pursuing a degree at a 2 or 4 year institution.

Frank and Margaret Hahn Scholarship

- * This scholarship is to help a graduating senior of South Decatur that will be pursuing a certificate, associates degree or bachelors degree in a medical or science field, including Agriculture.
- * Must show a financial need.

Don and Barb Horan Memorial Scholarship

- * This scholarship is to help a student in Decatur County that will graduate from Oldenburg Academy.

Delmar & Janet Knecht Family Memorial Scholarship

- * This scholarship is to support a student pursuing a 2 or 4 year degree and who has a B average or above

Dr. Irwin and Dot Lanning Scholarship

- * This scholarship is for a graduating senior from Greensburg, North Decatur, or South Decatur High School with a GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- * This student must plan to study in the field of Engineering, Agriculture, Education, Information Technology science or Math at an accredited 2 or 4 year institution.

Burney and Lucy Lehman Scholarship

- * This scholarship is given to a Greensburg student , and are disbursed for up to 4 years of post-secondary education..
- * The intent of the scholarship is to make a significant impact on graduating seniors who may have a difficult time attending a post-secondary institution.

Darryl P. Menefee Memorial Scholarship

- * This scholarship is for a graduating senior from North Decatur that has been a member or manager of the baseball team at some point.
- * This student must be pursuing a 2 or 4 year post-secondary education.

Meyer and Wilma Schrieber Memorial Scholarship

- * This scholarship is to help a Greensburg High graduating student attending a 4 year Baccalaureate program.

Howard G. Shake Scholarship

- * This scholarship is to help a North Decatur graduating student who may have a difficult time receiving a post-secondary education.

Robert E. Simmonds Memorial Scholarship

- * This scholarship is to help any graduating senior from Greensburg or North Decatur that will be pursuing a post-secondary degree in transportation mechanics.

George F. Tanner Memorial Scholarship

- * This scholarship is to help a North or South Decatur graduating student who is pursuing a degree in a foreign language and/or teaching.

Loren and Mary York Scholarship

- * This scholarship is to help a North or South Decatur graduating student seeking a post-secondary training in education or teaching.

Zetterberg Family Music Scholarship

- * This scholarship is to help a North or South Decatur graduating student seeking a post-secondary training in music.

National 4-H Conference

This is an annual premier national civic engagement opportunity for 4-H members across the country. Delegates will not only learn while at the conference, but will have the opportunity to practice and apply in a real world setting their newly developed and refined skills. Delegates choose an important societal topic and in round table groups prepare a briefing. During the conference, groups present their briefing to federal officials around the Washington, D.C. area. 4-H members in grade 10 - 12 may apply. One to four delegates will represent Indiana at National 4-H Conference.

- * This year the National 4-H Conference will be held virtually.
- * April 10-15, 2021 (be sure you can participate on these dates before you apply)
- * Application due December 1, 2020
- * Must submit application through your 4HOnline account
