ATTENTION ALL 4-H MEMBERS AND FAMILIES

At this point we wanted to let all 4-H members know that the Delaware County Fair has not been cancelled, if we cannot hold it during the current dates due to state restrictions we can postpone it to a later date. We encourage families to use this time at home to work on your projects.



4HOnline Deadline: The deadline for all animal species to be identified in the 4HOnline system to be eligible for the 4-H shows at the Indiana State Fair is now **June 1, 2020**. This date is the target date for Indiana State Fair bound animals. All DNA samples for all swine, beef, dairy beef, dairy feeders, sheep and meat goats will be due to the Extension Office by June 1st.

Indiana State Fair Entry: In the past, the Indiana State Fair has had an initial entry deadline of June 1st. In 2020 ISF will be extending their initial deadline to **July 1, 2020** to help accommodate 4-H families. Reminder - animals must be properly identified in 4HOnline by June 1st to be eligible for the Indiana State Fair 4-H shows.

Animal Identification Days (Weigh Ins): For 2020 only, we are asking 4-H members to pick up the necessary tags from the local Extension Offices. It will be up to the 4-H family to apply the tags to the animals themselves. Tags can be picked up starting **May 18**. We have ear taggers available to use with a deposit of \$15.

Kits for circuit boards, shake flashlights and trouble lights will be provided. **Boards for first year projects will not be provided.

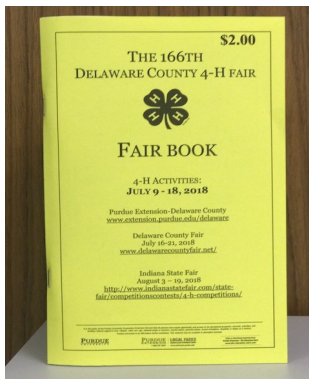

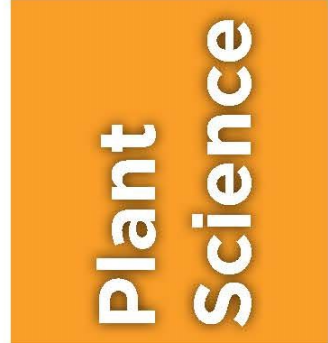

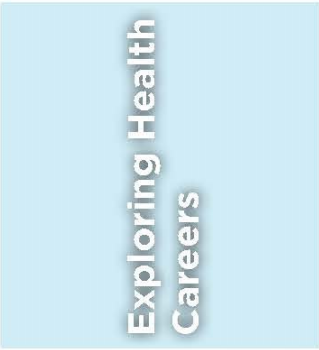
