

If you have forgotten your password, you can reset it and create a new password. Please check your address, phone, email, etc. and update any changes. Everyone planning on participating in 4-H for 2019-2020 must re-enroll at **4honline.com**. The state enrollment fee is \$15.00 per child, with a maximum of \$45.00 per family.


