



DINING WITH DIABETES (VIRTUAL 4-PART SERIES)

Diabetes is a very serious and costly health condition, but research has shown that those who learn to manage their blood glucose levels, exercise regularly, and eat healthy can lower their risks of complications and lead a healthier and more productive life. Learn up-to-date information on nutrition, meal planning, exercise, and how to understand common diabetes related medical tests. This is a weekly class that runs for four weeks. The four classes will be offered as morning or evening sessions on Tuesday, March 2nd, 9th, 16th, and 23rd. The morning session is from 10:00am-12:00pm. Evenings sessions are from 7:00pm-9:00pm. All classes will be held virtually through Zoom. A follow-up session will take place in June; date to be announced. The series costs \$25/person and includes a notebook and printed materials.
