



Arts & Crafts: FINE ARTS (PAINTING & DRAWING)

Exhibit Requirements

Requirements are the same for all levels:

BEGINNER: (Grades 3 - 5)
INTERMEDIATE: (Grades 6 - 8)
ADVANCED: (Grades 9 - 12)

EXHIBIT:

- One framed picture
- 4-H member must fill out a Floyd County Record Sheet and attach in Green Record Book.
- 4-H member must attach a description of what work they did to complete the exhibit.

PAINTING

- Make a painting using tempura, oil, pastels, acrylic or water color – on canvas, canvas board, or paper – framed as a picture – prepared for hanging. Canvas art on a wooden frame is considered prepared for hanging provided that frame has a hanger.
- If you use water colors, tempera, pastels, or water color, the picture is to be under glass and matted. If oils or acrylic are used, picture does not need to be under glass or matted.

DRAWING

- Make a drawing using charcoal, pencil, ink, chalk or oil pastels, or a combination – on canvas, canvas board, or paper – framed as a picture – prepared for hanging. Canvas art on a wooden frame is considered prepared for hanging provided that frame has a hanger.
- The picture is to be under glass and matted.
- Must be on canvas, Canvas Board or paper. All articles must be ready for use. (FOR EXAMPLE – Picture must be framed and have a hanger on back.)

All pictures must be framed, ready to hang with screw eye and wire, and back securely finished.

DO NOT tape to hold picture and glass in the frame.
