Project Introduction

Learn how to express yourself through creatively wrapping packages for all occasions.

- Show creativity in material chosen.
- Package for exhibit should not contain an article.
- Attach a card to the bottom of your package with the following information:
 - Occasion: _____
 - Age of person receiving the gift
 - Is the gift for male or female? _____
 - Materials used: _____ (see example card below)
- Besides Christmas & Birthdays, consider all the holidays and occasions for your theme.
- *Judging emphasis will be on originality and creativity.*
- All bows **MUST** be self-made after Grade 3!!!



Beginner Level

Grade 3

Exhibit: 1 wrapped box, square or rectangular with a purchased bow or decoration.

Grade 4

Exhibit: 1 wrapped box, square or rectangular with a self-made bow.

Grade 5

Exhibit: 1 small box, square or rectangular, suitable for ring or pin, with self-made bow and/or decorations.

Intermediate Level

Grade 6

Exhibit: 2 wrapped packages using any material other than paper and gift wrap ribbon. Be creative!

Grade 7

Exhibit: 2 packages, any shape, with wrapping paper you designed. No commercial paper may be used. May have bows or decorations, but not required.

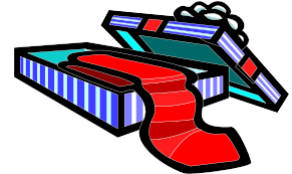
Grade 8

Exhibit: 2 wrapped packages, one cylinder-shaped, with a finished end as shown in the manual. Show creativity in materials you choose. Second package, shape of your choice.

Advanced Level

Grade 9

Exhibit: 1 package with the top and bottom wrapped separately so the judge can open it. The box must contain a liner, like tissue paper. It will be judged on the inside appearance and outside wrapping. The other package shape is your choosing. Bows are not required.



Grade 10

Exhibit: 2 packages you created and designed or used in a theme. Example: a train, a car, a clock, etc.

Grade 11

Exhibit: 2 packages, any shape, using recycled or natural materials. Include bows made out of recycled materials.

Grade 12

Exhibit: 2 packages - 1 package is a set of packages wrapped, at least three, in a tiered effect. The second package is a plain sack or bag which you have decorated.
