Project Introduction

The 4-H Sports Project is designed to display a 4-H member's favorite sport.

Exhibit Introduction

All poster exhibits are to be displayed horizontally, sized 22" x 28", mounted on a firm backing (foam-core board or other) and covered in clear plastic or transparent material. Place standard identification label with your name, grade and county in the lower right-hand corner of the poster.

All posters, notebooks, and display boards **MUST** include a reference list indicating where information was obtained, giving credit to the original author, to complete the 4-H member's exhibit. This reference list should/might include web site links, people and professionals interviewed, books, magazines, etc. It is recommended this reference list be attached to the back of a poster or display board, be the last page of a notebook, or included as part of the display visible to the public. A judge is not to discredit an exhibit for the manner in which references are listed.

Exhibit Requirements

Requirements the same for all Levels:

Level A: Grades 3 - 5

Level B: Grades 6 - 8

Level C: Grades 9 - 12

Exhibit:

- A scrapbook or 3 ring binder on **ONE** of your favorite sports, consisting of pictures, programs, rules, souvenirs, etc. Failure to keep a scrapbook confined to one sport will result in a place drop (dropped one ribbon grade). **MUST INCLUDE IN SCRAPBOOK EXAMPLES OF DO'S AND DONT'S OF SPORTSMANSHIP.**
- Complete a Floyd County Record Sheet and attach in your Green Record Folder. Must have record sheet when turning in project.

DO NOT ENTER PREVIOUSLY JUDGED MATERIAL.
