Be sure the project you wish to take to Showcase is selected in 4-H Online (v2.4honline.com) and then register it in Fair Entry which will be open April 26 through May 15.

This is a transition year for 4-H Online. This will be a good opportunity to re-establish our projects to meet the needs of today's youth. Most past non-animal projects will fit into state categories which may advance to the state fair. However, if you do not see a project listed below, you may request that it be brought back next year.
