## ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE SAFETY- County Only Project

There will be no State Fair exhibits for this project.

A completed record sheet signed by your 4-H leader must be presented, along with the exhibit, at project check-in at the fair.

**What You Can Learn From This Project:** Learn ATV safety practices, proper riding apparel, riding techniques, riding on differing terrains and in a variety of conditions. Workshops may be offered.

This project is divided into three levels according to the following breakdown:

Level 1	Grades 3, 4, & 5
Level 2	Grades 6, 7, & 8
Level 3	Grades 9 and above

## General Rules for Exhibits

- 1. All ATV posters must be 22" x 28", exhibited horizontally, must have a firm backing and be covered in clear plastic or other transparent material.
- 2. All ATV posters must have an appropriate title (of the exhibitor's choice).
- 3. Place a small label in the lower right hand corner of the poster exhibits, with the following information: Name, Age/Grade, Club, Project, and Level.
- 4. Refer to "How to Prepare a Poster Project" in this handbook for more details on preparing posters.
- 5. It is recommended/suggested that all posters, notebooks, and display boards include a reference list indicating where information was obtained, giving credit to the original author, to complete the 4-H member's exhibit. This reference list should/might include web site links, people and professionals interviewed, books, magazines, etc. It is recommended this reference list be attached to the back of a poster or display board, be the last page of a notebook, or included as part of the display visible to the public. A judge is not to discredit an exhibit for the manner in which references are listed or a lack thereof.

## **Exhibit Requirements:**

- **Level 1** Grades 3-5: Exhibit a safety poster on any topic covered in the 4-H ATV Rider Handbook.
- **Level 2** Grades 6-8: Exhibit a safety poster on any topic covered in the 4-H ATV Rider Handbook.
- Level 3 Grades 9 and above: Exhibit a safety poster on any topic covered in the 4-H ATV Rider Handbook.
