CRAFTS - FINE ARTS-County & State Fair Projects

There will be a minimum of 3 State Fair exhibits selected from this project.

A completed record sheet signed by your 4-H leader **must** be presented, along with your exhibit, at project check-in at the fair.

This project is divided into three levels according to the following breakdown:

Level 1	Grades 3, 4, & 5
Level 2	Grades 6, 7, & 8
Level 3	Grades 9 and above

General Rules

- 1. A 4-H'er may enter two Crafts-Fine Arts project.
- 2. All drawings or paintings must be on canvas, canvas board or paper framed as a picture prepared for hanging.
- 3. Exhibits must be framed as a picture and must be ready for hanging, with a **secure** hanger. Canvas art on a wooden frame is considered prepared for hanging provided that frame has a hanger.
- 4. Exhibits must be dry to the touch.
- 5. Frames may be of wood, metal, plastic, etc., with glass covering (except oil and acrylics). A picture in a mat alone is not considered framed. (Reference *Finishing Touches* has more information on framing.)
- 6. If the exhibit is not ready for hanging (no frame, no hanger, or is wet), it will be lowered one ribbon placing.
- 7. Exhibits will be judged by levels within each category (Drawing, Painting, and Watercolor). There will be a champion and reserve champion in each level of the three categories. There will be an overall champion and reserve champion for each category. A grand champion and reserve grand champion will be selected over all Fine Arts exhibits.
- 8. Exhibits should increase in difficulty with each year project is taken.
- 9. Attach to project 4-H 618A-W, "4-H Craft Information Card" for description of work completed on the project.

Exhibit Requirements

Exhibit a drawing or painting you have created from one of the following categories. 4-H Craft Information Card 4-H 618A-W, describing work completed on the project, must be attached to the exhibit.
